



ASCRS Clinical Practice Guidelines: Chronic Radiation Proctitis



✗ Prophylactic measures are insufficiently described and not routinely recommended (1C)

Formalin installation is effective for bleeding (1B)



Sucralfate enemas are moderately effective for bleeding (1A)



✗ Short chain fatty acids are not effective (1B)



✗ Alternative Treatments are not recommended (mesalamine, ozone, metronidazole, bipolar, RFA, laser, cryotherapy) 1C



Argon plasma is effective for bleeding (1B)
