# PRAGUE

**PRAGUE**, ancient capital of Charles IV's Bohemian Kingdom, has played a pivotal role in the development of Central Europe since the Middle Ages. An epic history has made it one of the most beautiful cities in the world and today tourism is a major force.

The illustrious history of the city dates back to the 9th century and Prague has many cultural, historical and natural treasures. Its economy continues to grow dynamically thanks to exports and the increased interest of foreign investors.

Since May 2004, the Czech Republic has been a member of the European Union; but it still uses its national currency, the Czech crown.

Even though the Czech Republic's area (78,864 sq. km) ranks it among small countries, its wealth of natural beauty and monuments of cultural heritage contribute greatly to its global prestige as a major cultural destination. Much of the post-communism reconstruction and regeneration of Prague has been driven by tourism, as ancient buildings have been transformed into fine restaurants and stylish hotels.

In 1992 the entire historical centre of Prague was listed in the UNESCO World Cultural & Natural Heritage Register.

## CONGRESS VENUE

The meeting will take place in the **Prague Congress Centre**, which provides extensive and excellent facilities for ESCP's 4th Congress. The Congress Centre enjoys a unique location on one of Prague's hills, just 2km from the old town, and is one of the dominant features of this capital city. From here you can view the wonderful panorama of Prague, and the Centre links with ease to the city centre by train.

Ruzyně International Airport is located 18km from the Prague Congress Centre and 20km from the city centre.
